


Looking Outside My Window Drawing Activity



Materials

Pencil • Colored pencils or crayons • Paper

Instructions



Step 1	Find your favorite window that you like to look out of.
Step 2	Using your pencil, draw the window and the view that you see through it. When you are ready, add some color to your drawing.
Step 3	Draw your window again, but this time, draw what you would like to see outside. We chose an island in Greece.
