## Marble Maze

Have you ever wanted to be a game designer? A marble maze is fun way to start! In this game, the player must guide a marble through a maze only by tilting the board. The designer can create a maze with various pathways and traps to make the game easier or harder. Look at these examples for inspiration and try creating your own to challenge your friends and family!


## Materials

Pencil • Glue • Ruler • Scissors • Cardboard base • Scrap cardboard • Marble

| Instructions | Start by measuring the amount of space your marble <br> needs to move between the wall pieces. Pick a <br> dimension that will allow your marble to roll freely. |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Step 2 | Using this measurement, lightly draw guidelines on your <br> cardboard base. These lines will help you position the <br> walls of the maze. Will your maze be a grid? A spiral? |
|  | Pick a starting point and an ending point on your base. <br> Map out the correct route that connects both points. <br> Then, draw in the rest of the maze to create challenges <br> like dead ends and wrong turns. |
| Step 4 | Darken the lines for your walls and erase any leftover <br> guidelines. Use the lines to measure and cut cardboard <br> pieces to be the walls. Make your maze 3D by gluing <br> the cardboard walls to your base on top of the lines. |
