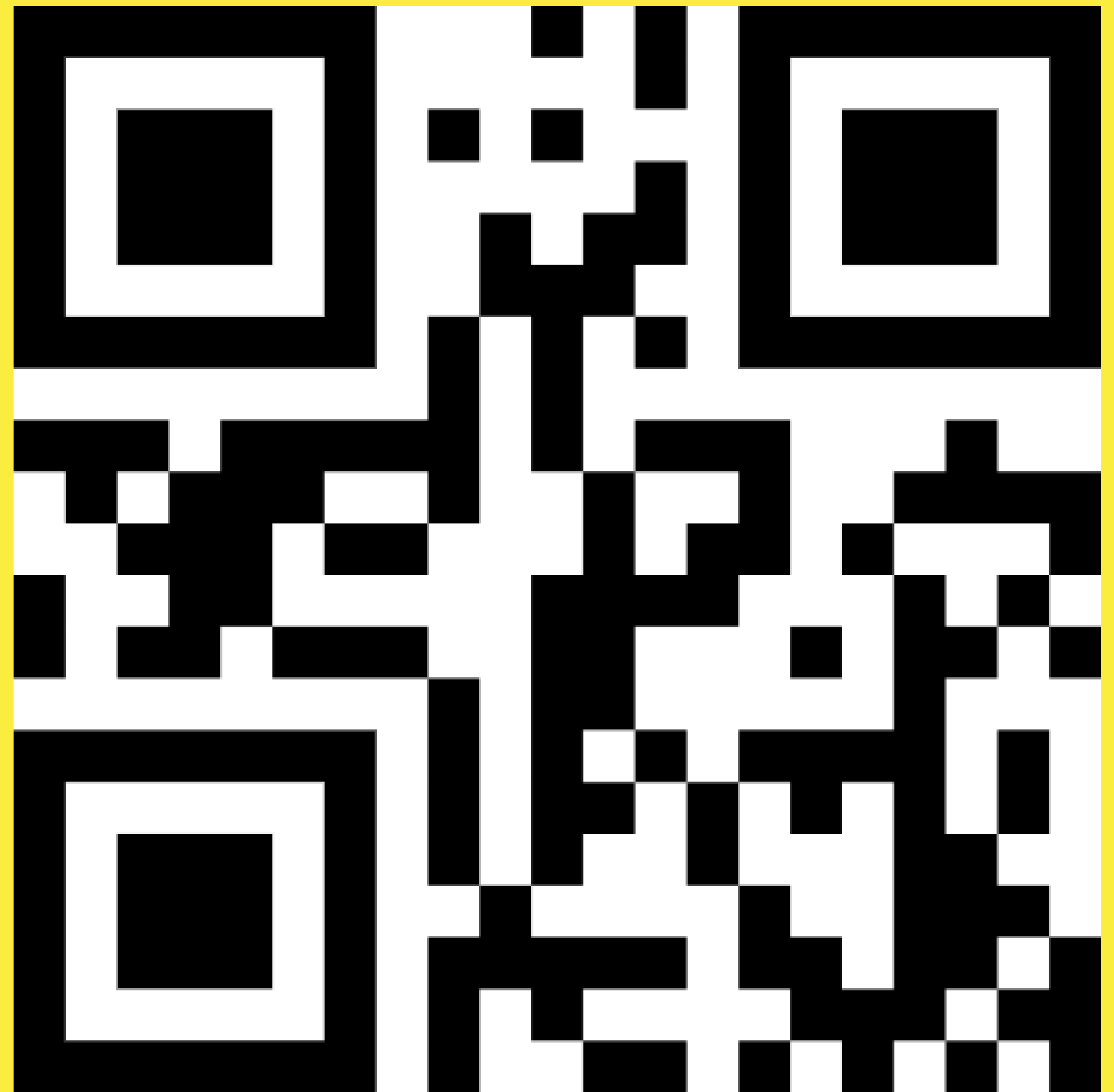

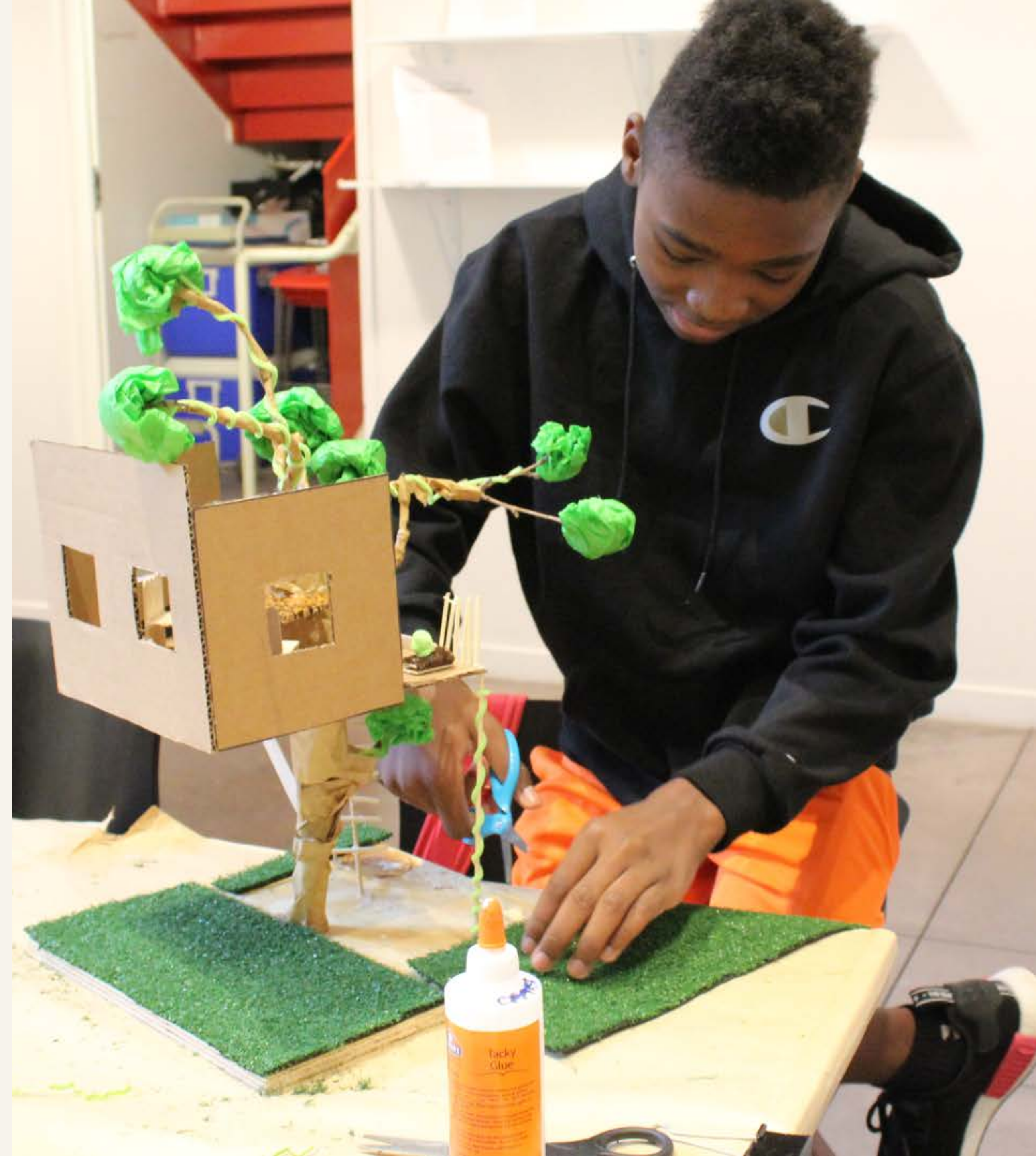



After School Programs

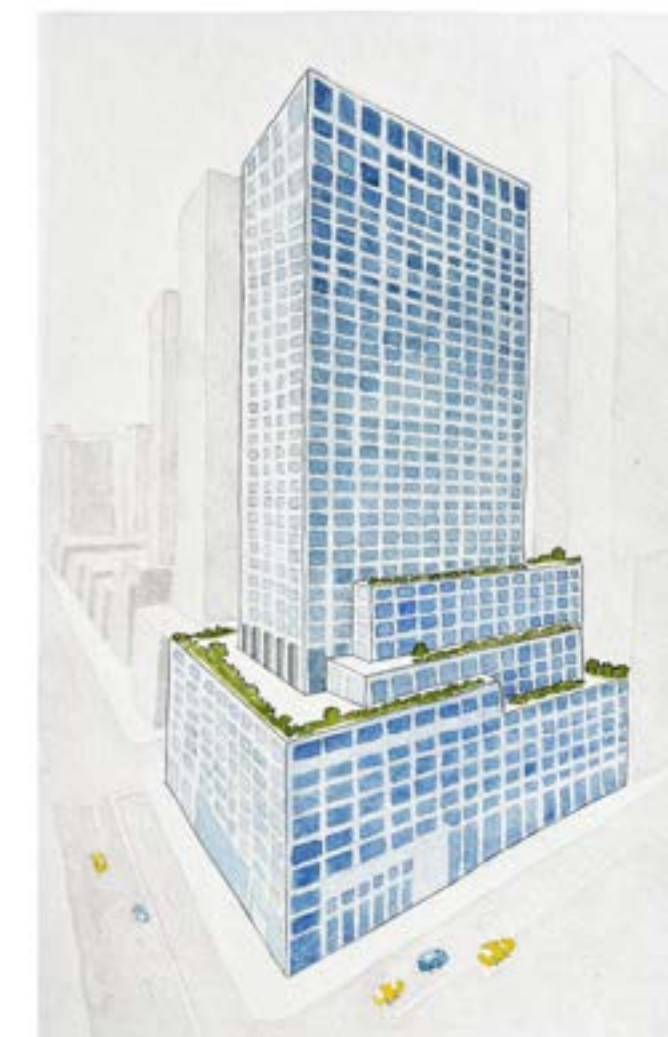

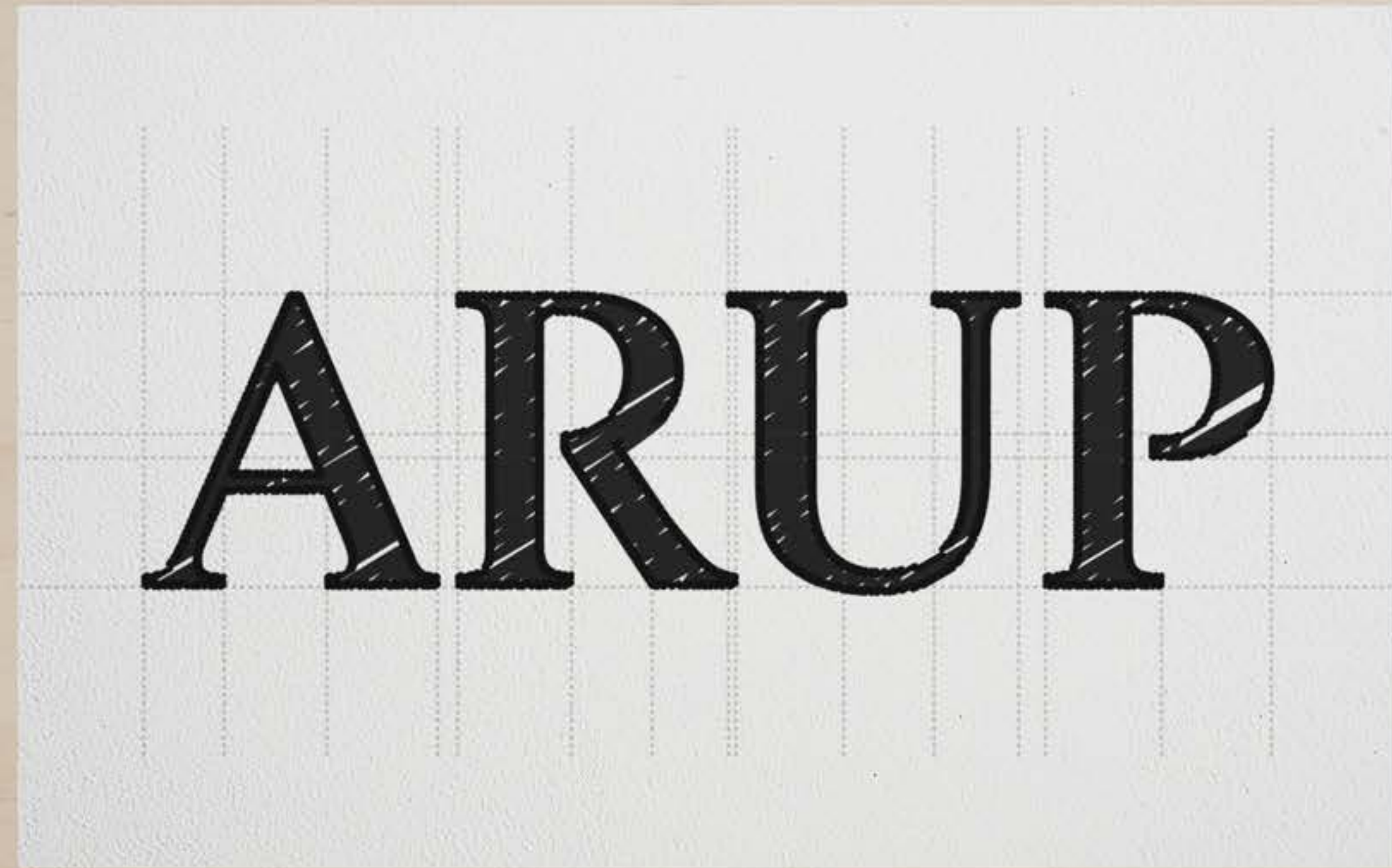

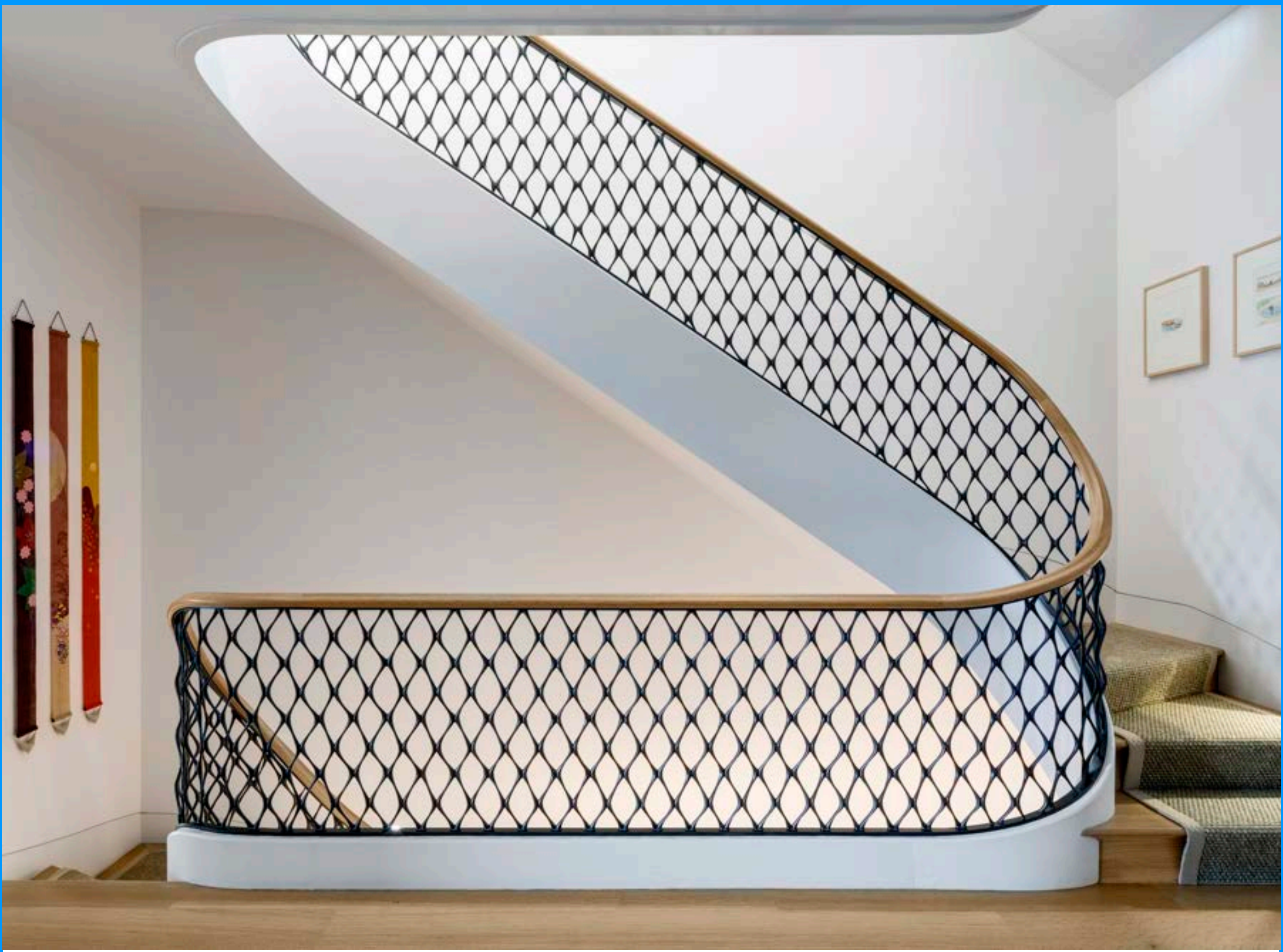
